Well that about does it for this month. The next meeting includes the Associate's softball challenge, which is always loads of fun. We are also looking for chairmen for the following socials:

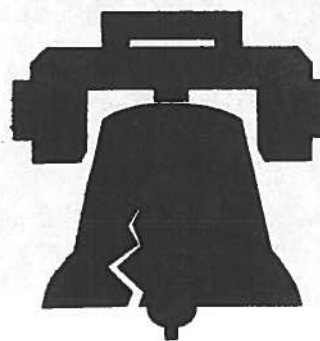

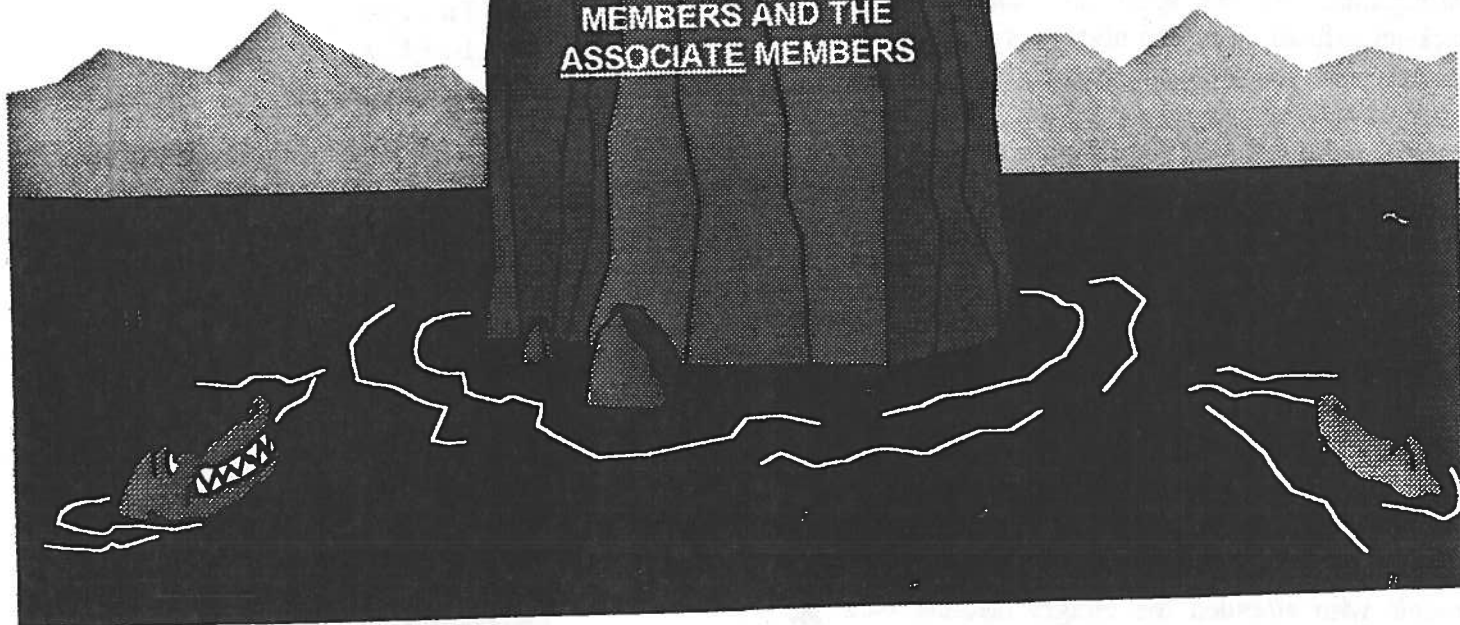

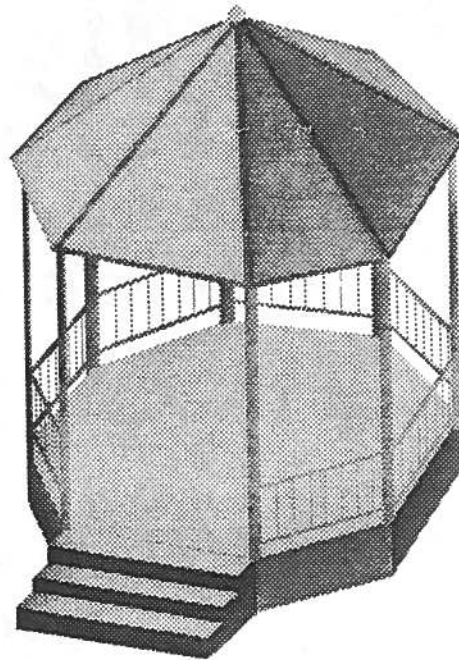
