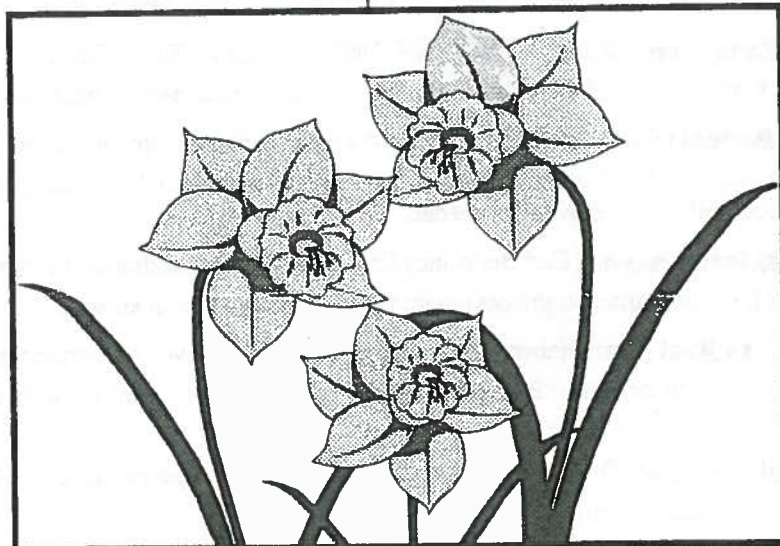

A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE BOARD POSITIONS:

CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD: The previous year's president automatically becomes the new chairman.

PRESIDENT: The "Head Honcho" and official spokesperson for the chapter is responsible for developing a planned year budget, chairing monthly General Membership and Board meetings and watching over all chapter business.

SECRETARY: The Secretary manages all Chapter correspondence, takes meeting minutes to be published in the Wise Fox Newsletter and handles the "Sunshine Fund".

TREASURER: The Treasurer is responsible for managing the chapter check book and working together with the President and Board of Directors in overseeing the yearly budget.

4 AREA VICE PRESIDENTS: The VP's are responsible for overseeing all of the projects that fall in their area. They must seek out proper chairmen for each project, help those chairmen when needed and prepare monthly progress reports for the Wise Fox Newsletter and the GM meetings. The four areas are: Individual Development, Community Development, Ways & Means and Membership. ID includes projects that benefit the member (training, socials, sports, etc). CD is projects that benefit the Community (Elder's Day, Santa on the Common, donations, etc). Ways & Means projects make the money that fuels the rest of the system (Haunted House, Xmas Tree Sales, etc). Membership projects help to gain and retain new members (Call nights, Membership Booths, New Member Barbecue).
