Hello friends.

The Foxboro Jaycees. The Blue Wave. We spend a lot of time and energy telling people who we are and what we have done. The variety and magnitude of contributions made to the Foxborough community for over 40 years are frequently chronicled and highly respected. Project success is often measured in comparison to the number of participants or amount of money raised year after year. Membership drives and publicity strive to demonstrate the breadth and depth of experiences and activities made available to members. While there is every reason for individual Jaycees and for the Chapter to be proud of these records, and there is certain nobility to upholding traditions, this persistently retrospective view has a few inherent limitations.

During September, US Jaycee President-elect Lon Fox visited Massachusetts and actually spent a Saturday morning here in Foxborough, mowing grass at Camp Lincoln Hill with the crew preparing the grounds for our haunted house. That afternoon, he spoke at the State Meeting in Mansfield, touched on critical issues faced by local chapters all over the country and his vision for the Jaycee movement. As Mr. Fox reminded us at that meeting, we in local chapters are constantly scrambling to encourage our fellow Jaycees to help with the important and valuable things we have planned to do. We could be excited about reaching out to new friends for fresh ideas, enthusiasm, and good company; yet we feel tremendous pressure to recruit new members as manpower. There is always a core group of people who will step up to help, but these people unfortunately reach a point when the sense of responsibility eclipses the joy of accomplishment. We become victims of our cumulative success. Eventually, in our fervor to get things done, 'we forget to ask Jaycees what they want to be doing.' I believe Mr. Fox was spot on with his analysis. And so I ask, my friends:

What inspired you to join the Jaycees in the first place?

What do you want to do as a Jaycee?

What do you wish to accomplish as a Jaycee? (Yes, this is a different question.)

What would you hope to share with fellow Jaycees?

What would you like to help the Chapter accomplish?

When that letter arrives, what will drive your decision to renew Jaycee membership? I offer these not as rhetorical questions, but rather as a real invitation for each of us to step back from the rush for just a moment and evaluate our goals and expectations as Jaycees. *The answers matter*. To have individual goals is not selfish; these are integral components of one's contribution to the organization. Our responses are the keys to vitality of the Chapter, our continued ability to serve our community, enrichment of leadership skills of chapter members, and the enjoyment of the fellowship of interested and interesting people. *Your* answers matter – please share them.
