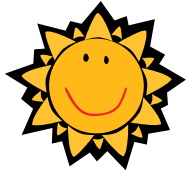

Concerts on the Common Membership Booth-Bob Gillis and friends

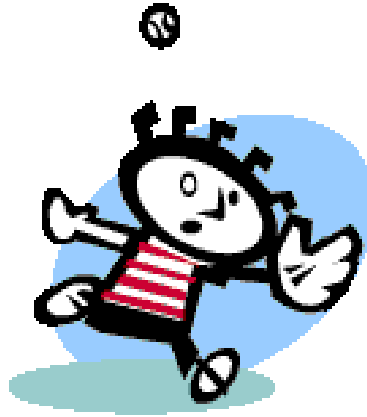
