Well, it's February already, and as some very nice people pointed out to me at the last board meeting, my term as President is almost up. That means it's time to start looking for some new board members.



If you have any thank you cards to be sent on behalf of the chapter, please let Heather Loew know. She is ready to send out some thanks!







Linda Magovern has called me with the idea to conduct a Karaoke Night. The American Legion recently held the same event and had some success. Linda will provide us with more details at the GM.


