Since we will be taking up the Inn, they are including a 5 -star dinner on Saturday night following the FREE Wine and Cheese party. There will also be two outstanding breakfasts included. Let's just put it this way, I enjoy the skiing, but I go to Mount Snow for the food and the hot tub!!!! The hot tub is a 15 person outside hot tub over looking Mount Snow. There are also saunas, and a bar. You bring your own alcohol and put it in the bar. You can also bring bottles of wine to have with dinner. There are three fireplaces, one in the bar next to the big screen t.v., and one on the top floor, one in the dining room, and there is also a t.v. room, and a pool table in the bar.
Prices are all inclusive for the weekend and include tax and gratuity.
