This month: Former Jaycee president Tom Sawran (1993-1994)

Continuing the trend of speaking with former Jaycee presidents, I am very happy to present these words from our 1993-1994 chapter president Tom Sawran, who enjoys the dubious distinction of being the man who swore me (and Susan) into the chapter in July of 1993 ©

Since that time, in my many talks with Tom, what is always evident is a deep love of this town, the Foxboro Jaycees, and a passion that we succeed. He was the first to run the Haunted House as a Foxboro Jaycees "on our own" event – "Run it like a business," and he later worked more magic and saved one of our final haunted houses at Payson Road by coordinating and installing a full septic system in a matter of days before we opened. While Tom is well known for telling you, "That's not how we did things back in the day," the truth is that so much of what the Jaycees did back then worked very well.

Over the years, he has served as both Jaycee mentor and friend to myself and Sue. So without further ado, let's hear from Tom.

The most memorable experience...

Tom: "Without question, the most memorable and proudest experience of my year as Jaycee President was the membership growth we accomplished. As I was being sworn in as President, I was also being aged out as a Rooster on the same night. (I still hold the record for actually being the oldest Foxboro Jaycee President in the history of our chapter, serving several months of my term as a 41 year old.) There was a fairly large group of us who all aged out the same night and with that, I made it my objective to above all else, strive for membership growth."

How he and his board approached membership growth...

Tom: "I had the great good fortune of having Patti O'Hara Howard and Beth Finch Madestra as my Membership V.P. and Director, respectively. To any request or idea that they would forward as to ideas regarding membership growth, my answer was <u>always</u> a resounding YES! Give it a try. Of course, the tried and true annual and historic "call night" program still proved to be the biggest and most successful program of the entire year."

Call nights...

Tom: "Call night was not just a random night or two with a few people bashfully or hesitantly making a few calls. Many, many nights were spent in advance with a sizable committee studying voter lists, residency lists, addresses etc. and compiling accurate "calling cards" with phone numbers. Call night actually lasted all week with at least 6-8 people per night working for a solid 2-3 hours each night."

Follow up...

Tom: "Any perspective who expressed even a slight interest was given the date of a planned orientation meeting, a reminder call several days later, and in the case of the most successful month we had [I believe in the history of the chapter], was invited to the October GM. We had 26 perspective members at the October GM alone, and eventually signed up 20 new members that month, which credited our Chapter with having made an "in-chapter extension," the same as having created a whole new chapter. We were national news in the Jaycee community. And of course, while also being a great membership draw, the Haunted House was in all likelihood the very best activation tool the chapter has ever known."

Success story...

Tom: "I think we put in about 35 new members in total for the year. It happened because membership growth, while being led by several very aggressive and creative members, as was repeatedly being reminded to all, was EVERYBODY'S JOB. Service to Humanity may be the best work of Life, but it can't be done without constantly renewing the most valuable resource of the organization—MEMBERS."
