Relay For Life - Chairman Needed - June 20th

Once again, the Jaycees will put together a team for this years' event...we need a leader to coordinate our efforts. Let me know if you're interested in joining our walkers or chair this project.

National Night Out - Chairman Needed - August 5th

We will be teaming up with the Foxborough Police to bring awareness to our town families on the importance of safety or our children and all members of our town. We had huge support last year and our participation was greatly appreciated by all who participated. If you would like to chair this, your responsibility would be to meet with Chief O'Leary to help coordinate this event.

Farm Stand Help - Chairman Needed

The farm stand we recently vandalized, we would like to be involved with helping raise funds and as a helping hand during construction, etc. A fund has been set up by farmstand coordinators with the support of the Discretionary Fund to get the stand ready in time for its opening in July. The goal is to raise \$8,000 to \$10,000 for repairs. The cost includes funds to provide a refrigeration unit of some kind. A trailer has been donated for that, and the plan is to outfit the trailer with a cooling unit, insulation and shelving units for food storage. So far, \$3,500 has been raised from three donors: two of them anonymous and the third, Foxboro resident Michele Gawronski, the farmstand coordinator and owner of Mangiacotti, who donated \$500. If you have any ideas on fundraising efforts or would like to be the Jaycee liaison for construction efforts, let me know.

Sentinel Project – <u>Chairman Needed</u>

Our beloved Sentinel is in need of repair ... we have been approached by a sophomore at Foxborough High School. As part of her Girl Scout Gold Award project, she has been helping to raise funds to preserve the Silent Sentinel statue atop Memorial Hall. She has received a \$1,000 grant from the Rotary Club and a \$500 grant from the Lions Club, and has reached out to us for a \$500.00 donation. My hope is that we could get someone to step up and develop a plan to raise these funds to help out. If you're interested or have some ideas, please contact me.


