Slightly less than a year ago the Jaycees began collecting shoes and we continue to do so. To date the Jaycees have shipped 43 boxes to Community Recycling weighing in at 1 Ton and 382 lbs! That's 1 Ton of shoes kept out of landfills, which directly helps the planet. This drive has raised \$638.50 in funds. Each pound earns .50 for the chapter.
