Location – Ball field TBD and then the SFCC




Book Club – Lisa Jolicoeur - 8/5 (Zoom)

• This month it is "The Stationary Shop" by Marjan Kamali

On Thursday evening, July 1, 2021, only a few Book Club members gathered to discuss "The Four Winds," Kristen Hannah's popular best seller about a family of Depression era farmers struggling to survive and the westward journey to find a new life. We enjoyed the book immensely and exchanged emails with book club members unable to attend due to vacations, so we will discuss this novel again when others can attend at the next meeting on Thursday, August 5, 2021.

After a brief discussion of "The Four Winds," we talked about other books, such as Olive Collins' "The Tide Between Us," which follows the 1821 saga of Arthur O'Neill, a young Irish boy enslaved with 2000 other young Irish boys on a ship bound for Jamaica, where they will be forced to work on sugar plantations; Tracy Chevalier's "A Single Thread" which follows the challenges single women faced between WWI and WWII as spinsters; and a few others that appeared in a link about historical novels related to women.





We selected Marjan Kamali's "Stationary Shop" for our August book club: set against an uprising in Tehran, the novel follows Raya and Bahman as they endure 1950s political upheaval in Tehran, strife between classes and gender equality, and young love that brings the story full circle to modern day in the United States.
